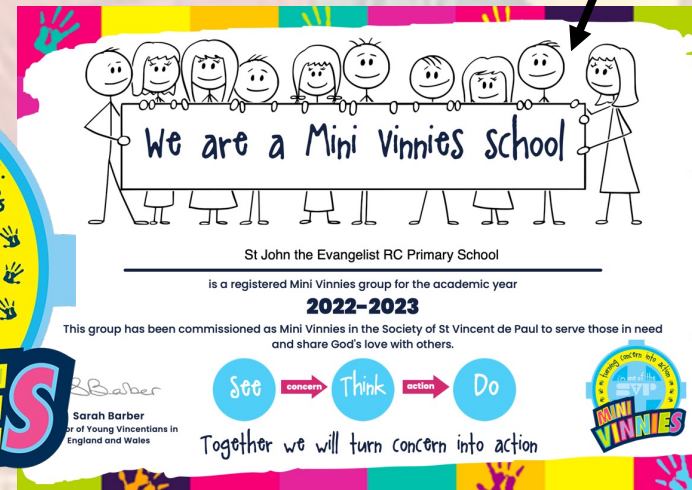
Each week, the Caritas Ambassadors present the “Catholic Social Teaching Award” to a member of our school who has acted out the CST objectives.
